# **COVID-19 Food Truck/Trailer Guidance**

Please adhere to the following guidelines to assist in minimizing risk to citizens and food truck/trailer employees:

#### **Permits**

 Food trucks and/or trailers are required to obtain a permit through Shallowater City Hall to operate inside the city limits of Shallowater.

## Gathering(s)

- The Governor of Texas, the Lubbock County Judge, and the Mayor of Shallowater have issued disaster declarations and/or executive orders limiting any gathering to <u>members</u> <u>of the same household only</u>. For essential services such as providing food, we must do everything possible to avoid creating an environment that promotes or causes any type of gathering.
- Activities outside of ordering and picking up food such as live music or other entertainment should be avoided to keep from creating an atmosphere where people may gather.

### Time, Distance, Shielding

- Less time spent near or with others helps minimize the chances of contracting the Corona virus.
- Physical separation of at least 6 feet minimizes individual's chances of contracting the Corona virus.

# Time, Distance, Shielding Continued

 A barrier (shield) between customer and food server provides a form of protection for both parties when unable to maintain a safe distance of physical separation.

### **Actions**

- Having customers call in orders minimizes the amount of time individuals are closer than 6 feet to each other.
- If possible, have customers pay for their order over the phone. This reduces the need to exchange items, as well as limits the interaction time between customer and employee.
- Use physical distancing by remaining 6 feet or more apart at all times possible.
- Have customers stay in their vehicle while waiting on an order.
- Only allow one order at a time to be picked up at the food truck/trailer. Allow the customer time to return to their vehicle before calling the next customer.
- If having the customer pick up their order at the window, place order outside of window and close window before customer retrieves order. This puts a shield between the customer and employee when distancing is not possible.
- Deliver order to the customer's vehicle if possible.
- Wear face covering when interacting with customers.
- Thoroughly wash hands after every customer interaction.
