- Must be a Commercial Business using ATV/UTV to conduct that business

***This ATV/UTV has all the required equipment installed to meet the standards of City of Shallowater ATV/UTV Ordinance. The inspected equipment is required to remain installed and in good working order for the duration of the requested two-year registration period.***

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# City of Shallowater ATV/UTV Inspection Form

*I understand that I am required to abide by all of the City of Shallowater ATV/UTV ordinance including, but not limited to;*

- **ATV/UTV is for Commercial Businesses only** and will only be used during that businesses' hours
- The registration sticker be maintained to be clearly visible on the ATV/UTV,
- Carrying proof of insurance for the ATV/UTV itself beyond my current auto insurance policy,
- ATV/UTV is required to have a Texas issued license plate
- Not allowing an unlicensed or underage person to drive the ATV/UTV,
- ATV/UTVs are limited to the number of persons that there are factory installed seating,
- **\*\*\*EFFECTIVE SEPT. 1, 2020 ALL OCCUPANTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR HELMETS AND EYE PROTECTION IF UTV DOES NOT HAVE BENCHSEATS WITH SEATBLETS AND A ROLL CAGE INSTALLED**
- That all passengers must have their own seats and not be seated on the lap of another person,
- That all passengers must be seated at all times when the ATV/UTV is in motion and no person younger than six (6) years-of-age may be transported in the ATV/UTV unless restrained by a safety belt restraint,
- ATV/UTVs shall not be operated during inclement weather or when visibility is impaired by weather or when there is insufficient light to clearly see a person or vehicle from a distance of five hundred feet (500'),
- ATV/UTV's can only be driven during daylight hours only (sunrise to sunset)
- ATV/UTVs shall not be operated on any sidewalk, pedestrian walkway, jogging path, or other location used for pedestrian traffic,
- ATV/UTVs are authorized to use the full lane of traffic on authorized streets
  - Authorized streets are City roadways with a posted speed limit of 35 MPH or less, this excludes all non-city streets or roadways with posted speed limits greater than 35 MPH,
  - A ATV/UTV is allowed to cross 12<sup>th</sup> Street, Avenue Q, and Loop 388 (Clovis Road) but shall not be driven on them
- ATV/UTVs shall not be driven between the lanes of traffic or between rows of stopped vehicles on the roadway,
- ATV/UTVs shall not be used to tow other ATV/UTVs or trailers on the roadway

**Violations of the City of Shallowater ATV/UTV ordinance may result in penalties including but not limited to a citation being issued; the ATV/UTV being towed; and/or an immediate revocation of the permit by an officer removing it from the ATV/UTV.**

**I acknowledge by signing below that I have read and understand that I must follow the entirety of the City of Shallowater ATV/UTV Ordinance and that what is listed above is just a summary of the ordinance. I further acknowledge and understand the possible penalties of a violation of this ordinance.**
