Consider Bills payable:

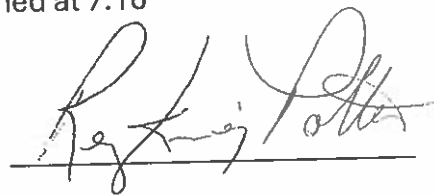
Alderman Jason White made a motion and Alderman Troy White made the second with all in favor.
