Introduction of our new city attorney

Department Reports:

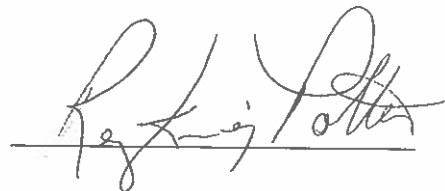
