Pledge of Allegiance: The meeting was opened at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Royking Potter.

Invocation: Invocation was offered by Mayor Potter.

Announcements- Mayor Potter mentioned the loss of Mr. Danny Rhodes. He said Mr. Rhodes was a long-time resident of Shallowater and would be greatly missed.

Public Comment- The floor was open for public comments at 7:02. There was no one present to speak.

**Consider and discuss water and sewer updates and engineering report-
Leonard Nail, Parkhill**

Leonard said things are still moving forward. He said that crews will be out this week to survey for the easements. He mentioned needing to check a sewer line that might be in the way as well. After the survey is done, the attorney will take over to get everything ready to be filed at the courthouse.

**Consider and take action on Veolia quote for a screen for the HDMI on
EDR #2**

Ruben said the purchase is necessary. He said the screen went out and that at this time they are able to control it. The order would be 5-6 weeks out for delivery. Alderman Waltisperger asked if it will be all one unit. Ruben said yes. Mayor Potter asked Alderman Waltisperger if he thought it was the best option and he said yes. Alderman Waltisperger made a motion to accept the quote. Alderman J. White made the second. Motion carried with 3 in favor and Alderman T. White and Alderman Cody absent.

**Consider and take action on Town Web's proposal for an upgraded
website and communication platform**

Nikki explained that there were two options. Town Web is upgrading things on their end which carries over to us. Option one was changing design and upgrading to the new platform. Option two was to simply upgrade to the platform but keep our original design. She explained our design is fine the way it is and suggested the cheaper option of doing just the upgrade to the platform. Everyone agreed that the design was fine the way it is. Alderman Carr made a motion to accept the cheaper option of the quote to upgrade to the platform only. Alderman J. White made the second. Motion carried with 3 in favor and Alderman T. White and Alderman Cody absent.

Consider and take action on Tyler Technologies quote for an output processor server

Nikki explained that the output processor server is a great option for the city. It would allow for a more streamlined process for billing and payroll among other things. She said there is a small annual fee but the monthly fee we pay now would go away. She said this option will save the city money in a few different areas. Alderman Waltisperger made a motion to accept the quote. Alderman J. White made the second. Motion carried with 3 in favor and Alderman T. White and Alderman Cody absent.

Consider and take action on Tx Health Benefits Pool official ballot

Nikki explained that Elena Quintanilla, City Manager for the City of Ransom Canyon is on the ballot. She said Elena does a great job at keeping everyone informed and has served on the board for more than five years. Alderman Carr motioned to have the vote go to Elena. Alderman J. White made the second. Motion carried with 3 in favor and Alderman T. White and Alderman Cody absent.

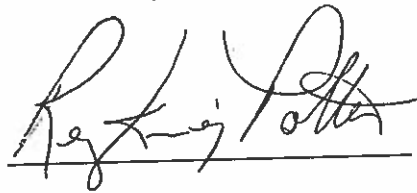
Consider and take action on minutes of previous meeting(s)
